Read this quickly, hide it, then impress friends and family with your extensive wine knowledge. Great for first dates too.

Merlot grape traces its ancestry to the first century, although the "Merlot" grape was not named as a distinct variety until the 1800s. It is mellow, but still complex, and is known for flavors of plum, black cherry, violets, and orange. It is a perfect match for beef and other medium-heavy dishes. Merlot is an excellent compliment to chocolate.

Shiraz and Syrah are names for the same grape. It is called Shiraz in Australia and Syrah in all other countries. Australia considers it to be the finest red wine grown there. Shiraz is known for its spicy blackberry, plum, and peppery flavors. Often there are additional notes of licorice, bitter chocolate and mocha.

Cabernet Sauvignon is known as one of the world's finest red wines, with depth of complexity and richness of flavor. Cabernets have a deep red color, with the primary taste being black currant. Other overtones can include blackberry and mint. When traditionally aged in oak, the wine takes on an oaky, vanilla flavor.

Red Zinfandel is mostly grown in California. The grape grows its best in cool, coastal locations. The color of Zin is deep red, bordering on black. Zinfandel is a spicy, peppery wine, with a hint of berries or dark cherries. It is one of the most popular wines in California.

White Wines

We spent many long, arduous, painstaking hours testing these wines so that you could be confident that any selection will be a great choice. Our white wines tend to be on the dry side, with the exception of the White Zin. It may take time for us to get over the pain of all that tasting, but you were worth it. Perhaps a bottle of “Frog’s Leap” Sauvignon Blanc will help ease the pain...

Frogstone “Wine-Knows”

There will be a test at the end of your meal, and spelling counts, so study up.

The Chardonnay grape is thought to have originated in Lebanon. In France, Chardonnay became the only grape allowed to be grown in Chablis, Burgundy. Its popularity has grown immensely in the past forty years, to where it is now the most popular white wine available. Typical flavors are apple, tangerine, lemon, lime, melon, and oak.

Sauvignon Blanc has been used for generations in France, and came to California in 1878. Sauvignon Blanc wines are typically very light and have pronounced flavors of herbs, olives, and sometimes light smoke..

Pinot Gris and Pinot Grigio (PEE-noh GREE and PEA-no GREE-jzhee-o) are actually the same white grape, with two different names. The Pinot grape is a mutation of the Pinot Noir grape, which is red. Pinot Blanc is not the same as Pinot Gris or Pinot Grigio - it is a further mutation of this grape. The Italian version is dry & light, with a mineral taste to it. Say “Pinot Grigio” 10 times fast

Riesling is a late-ripening grape, producing a sweet but complex white wine that ages very well. Typical Riesling flavors include fruity and floral, as well as honey and musky. In Ontario, Riesling is used in the creation of Ice Wines.

Gewurztraminer (guh-VURTS-trah-mee-ner) is on the wine list because we love to say “gewürztraminer”. Say it again. Gewürz means “spicy” in German and is the grapes main characteristic. Traminer means “coming from Tramin”, a small city in Austria. They’re highly fragrant and known for their crisp, spicy attributes, with flavors of roses (or flowers in general), and spices such as cloves and nutmeg.
